Powerplay Indoor Netball League Terms and Conditions

Auckland Netball reserve the right to have Auckland Netball Centre (ANC)-specific Terms and Conditions.

COMPETITION FORMAT

Each of our Powerplay Leagues may include grading games, competition round games, semi-finals and finals, depending on the number of teams that enter, and the format determined by Auckland Netball.

ANC is responsible for the grading of teams and reserves the right to grade any player or team or re-number or rename any team.

POWERPLAY LEAGUE FEES

All our Powerplay leagues are a pay-as-you-play system, with teams paying a team game fee prior to the start of each game. This fee is a team fee and **must be paid in full** regardless of the number of players a team may have playing in any particular game. Teams may also pay the entire season upfront.

PREFERRED PLAYING DAYS/TIMES

Teams are asked to select the day that they would prefer to play their games on, however, spaces are limited and therefore teams may be put on a waiting list if the preferred playing day is full.

Requests for deferred games or specific game times will not be accepted. However, Auckland Netball reserve the right to alter game schedules where deemed necessary and to have the final determination on the date and time for any rescheduled game. Auckland Netball will endeavour to distribute team game times as evenly as possible.

DEFAULTED GAMES

All teams are expected to play all of the games scheduled for their team, irrespective of the playing time. Teams that wish to default a game must advise the ANC office as soon as they are aware that they will be defaulting. If defaults are notified prior to the game, ANC shall contact the opposing team. Teams who have been advised of a default may choose to still play and pay for a non-competition game, provided ANC can arrange for this game to occur. If the team that is defaulted against chooses not to play, they are not required to turn up or pay for that game. Teams that have been defaulted against, will gain full points.

ANC may, in its discretion, withdraw from the competition any team that defaults three weeks in succession.

CANCELLATION AND DEFAULT FEES

No refunds will be given for any programmes, tournaments, competitions, or leagues entered into. Teams that cancel or default any scheduled game will be charged the appropriate default fee as detailed in their registration information. This fee must be paid prior to the start of the team's next scheduled game.

WITHDRAWAL OF TEAMS

Auckland Netball reserves the right to remove any team who defaults any scheduled game or brings the league into disrepute. Should a team wish to withdraw or is removed from the league during the season, all outstanding team fees must be paid in full before their withdrawal is completed.

TEAMS / FINALS QUALIFICATION

By ticking the Terms and Conditions Agreement box you are acknowledging that you are registering a full team with enough players to take the court and that your team is ready to play from the round's start date.

To qualify to play in a team in any game during a finals format, a player must have been registered as a member of that team and taken the court at least three times during the round robin games played by that team leading up to the finals.

PLAYER APPAREL

All players must wear clothing and footwear that is suitable for playing sport in. Work clothing and footwear, black soled shoes, jeans, and other such clothing are not permitted to be worn on our courts. For safety reasons players are not permitted to play without suitable footwear. Please also note that players are not permitted to take the court wearing any form of jewellery that may cause injury to themselves or another player.

CODE OF CONDUCT

ANC's Code of Conduct governs any member, player, team, umpire, coach, manager, volunteer, or any other person who participates, spectates, and / or is involved in any way in any activity held at ANC's facilities or is involved in any activity under the auspices of ANC.

Auckland Netball Centre Code of Conduct:

- Be fair and honest at all times
- Be responsible for your own actions
- Do not abuse others verbally or physically
- Do not discriminate against others
- Be safety conscious for yourself and others at all times
- Be a positive role model

Unacceptable Behaviour

- Violence in any form.
- Assault by any member or spectator on another person.
- Verbal abuse by any member or spectator towards any other member or spectator.
